**Annual Report of Board Member Continuing Education Training Credit - Hours

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**Background Information and Rationale:**

State Board of Education rules require board members annually to participate in continuing education in fulfillment of assessed needs. In the first year of service, board members must receive at least eight hours of continuing education in fulfillment of assessed needs, in which three (3) hours must be teambuilding for the team of eight. HB2563 directs the board, at the last regular meeting of the calendar year, to include in the minutes whether each trustee has completed all the training required as found in BBD LEGAL. Following the first year of service, board members must receive at least five hours of continuing education annually in fulfillment of assessed needs.

Experienced Board members: Paul Mostella, Felix Landin, Stephen Hoelscher, Kim Johnson, Jan Mostella, and John Samaniego, *have exceeded the five (5) hours of training required* by State Board rule; Attendance has also been included for meeting of record.


